PROJECT HISTORY & INFORMATION

The Hills of Itasca is an unincorporated subdivision in Addison Township that is currently on private wells and individual septic systems. Recently the treatment plant has been reconstructed and there is an existing sanitary sewer main connected to the neighborhood that could be extended to serve more properties. In addition the County provides water service through our Nordic Water System in the subdivision adjacent to the west from here and could extend mains as needed to improve water quality with a municipally treated and

monitored source and provide fire protection within the neighborhood. Multiple projects with various scopes could be completed in this area from preliminary engineering to sanitary system lining which would eliminate infiltration to the treatment plant to watermain extensions into the neighborhood. These projects could benefit 20+ residential properties.
